Petersfield Museum is looking for volunteers to help us deliver our early years group 'Museum Mischief Makers'. These weekly parent and toddler sessions will support local families in engaging and feeling comfortable in a museum setting at the same time as exploring the Museum's collections in a fun and accessible way.

Responsibilities:

- To assist with the setting up, delivery and tidying up of the Museum's weekly early years sessions
- Taking photos of sessions in action and obtaining permission forms
- Supporting the gathering of feedback from families
- Assisting at other early years themed events, including our popular Toddler Takeover Days

Commitment:

Volunteers are welcome to offer as much or as little of their time as they can give, but we do encourage individuals to commit to regular shifts. Our recommended commitment for the Early Years Volunteer is one 2-hour shift per fortnight.

What we're looking for:

- Polite and friendly individuals over the age of 16
- Confidence and enthusiasm for engaging with preschool children and their parents/guardians
- Individuals who enjoy working as part of a small, dedicated team
- An enthusiasm to develop knowledge of Petersfield Museum and its collections and share this in a positive and lively way
- Ability to undertake regular shifts, including during school holidays
- Willingness to undertake a DBS check (paid for by the museum)
