Photography Competition

About your photographs:

- Photographs can be traditional head and shoulder portraits, or photographs of the subject in action.
- You may not enter an image that has been published elsewhere or has been entered into other photographic competitions.
- Photographs must have been taken within the last 2 years.
- Photographs can be orientated in landscape or portrait.
- Photograph subject/s must be aware photograph is being taken and have given permission for its use.
- If your image features children under the age of 18, you must have their parents'/guardian(s)' legal consent for the image to be published.
- Photographs must be accompanied with a short piece of text that explains:
 - who the subject is
 - the subject's connection to Petersfield, such as: their positive impact or contribution to the community or why they love the town. This can be in the form of a direct quote from them or written by yourself with the subject's permission.
- You may take the photograph using film, but you must submit a digital JPEG version of it.
- Entries may be in black and white or in colour.
- Entries must be JPEG files of at least 1Mb in file size (maximum file size 5 Mb). Photographs must be at least 300 dpi in .jpg format and fit in a 19x24 inch frame.
- Maximum three entries per person

Submitting your entry

- Email up to three of your high quality photographs, at least 300 dpi in .jpg format, along with short summaries, to assistantcurator@petersfieldmuseum.co.uk
- Please also submit your name, address and telephone number.
- Entries will not be accepted by post or hand.
- The Competition will open for entries on **Thursday 1st July 2021** and will close at **23:59 GMT on Friday 31st December 2021**. Entries received after this deadline will not be accepted.

The winners

- Six winning photographs will be selected.
- Prize: The six winners will have their work displayed in the new museum for a year and win a ticket to the museum for themselves and one guest.
- Short-listing will take place in January 2022. The winning images will be chosen from a shortlist by a panel of judges. The winners will be contacted directly.
- The judges' decision will be final and no discussion will be entered into regarding the results.

By entering the competition, you are deemed to accept these Terms and Conditions:

Competition is open to both professional and amateur photographers of all ages, but if you are under 18 you must have a parent or legal guardian's permission to enter.

By entering, you agree that all images can be used in the future on social media or promotional material with a full attribution by Petersfield Museum.

You are responsible for informing us of any changes to your contact details before the closing date.

You will not submit any photographs that are obscene, vulgar, pornographic, hateful, threatening, racist, sexist or discriminatory. If your image features children under the age of 18, you must have their parents'/guardian(s)' legal consent for the image to be published. We reserve the right to examine any or all legal consents. Petersfield Museum reserves the right to refuse images they consider unsuitable in any way.

By entering, you confirm that:

- You are the sole author of each entry and that it is your original work.
- You own the copyright and any other intellectual property rights of each image.
- You have the permission of those pictured in the image (or, where the image shows any persons under 18, the consent of their parent or guardian) for the image to be published and indemnify Petersfield Museum against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement.

- You agree to take part in any post-competition publicity as requested by Petersfield Museum.
- By entering the competition, you grant Petersfield Museum a non-exclusive, irrevocable license to reproduce, enlarge, publish or exhibit the images on any and all media platforms.
- The photographer must be the sole author and owner of the copyright of photographs entered into the competition. You will retain full copyright for your image and, wherever possible, will be credited if your image is published by Petersfield Museum.
