- Mind map words

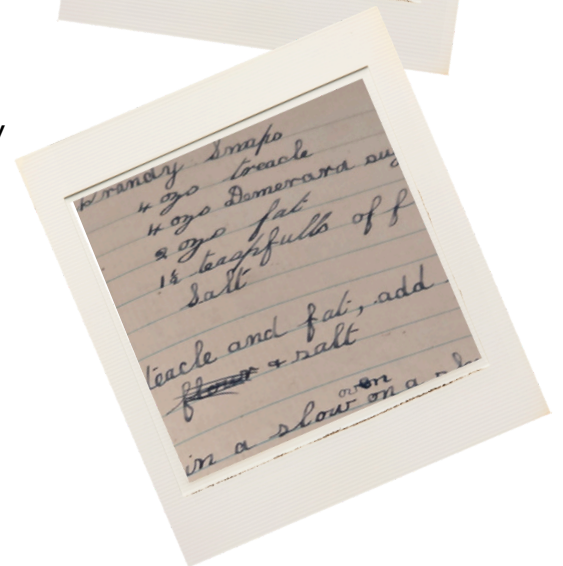
